ABOUT JLSP

For over 90 years, the Junior League of Saint Paul (JLSP) has retained a rich tradition of serving the greater Saint Paul area through community service projects and by training women volunteers. Established in 1917 by Saint Paul native Elizabeth Ames Jackson, JLSP was the 19th Junior League created following the 1901 inception of the first Junior League in New York City. Today we are proud to have over 350 members from all backgrounds. Any woman with an interest in voluntarism and a commitment to our mission is welcomed to join JLSP.

Our new *Building Bonds through Reading and Play* initiative seeks to promote literacy, play and bonding between parents and children. This initiative includes two program components: Library Kids and Saint Paul Plays!

Library Kids addresses the need to improve the literacy rate among children in Saint Paul. In partnership with the Saint Paul Public Schools, all pre-kindergartners in the city are given their own early-reader book and information about the importance of reading and how to access the library. In partnership with Saint Paul and

Ramsey County libraries, we threw a party for over 200 new kindergarten library card holders

Saint Paul Plays! is a partnership between JLSP and the Department of Parks and Recreation, fostered by the Mayor's office. JLSP hosted sixteen game events, serving approximately 240 attendees, at area recreation centers: Arlington, Dayton's Bluff, Hancock, Jimmy Lee, McDonough, and Mt. Airy.
