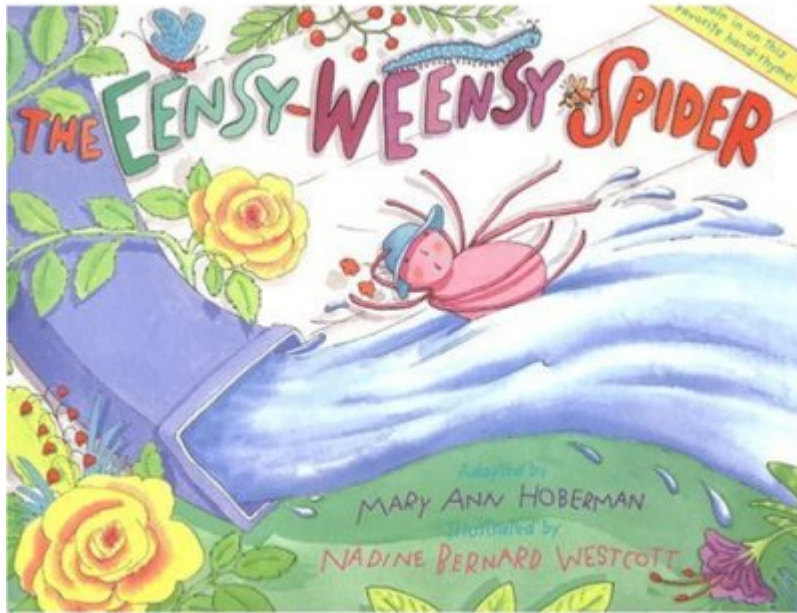




## 2007-2008 Book of the Year
