Transfer Information

A JLSP member in good standing may transfer her membership to another Junior League, according to the receiving Junior League's transfer requirements. The JLSP may accept the transfer membership of a member from another Junior League, subject to the following requirements:

a) New Member Transfers

- 1) New Members of another Junior League may transfer to the JLSP by submitting a written request for transfer to the Director of Membership by mail to JLSP Headquarters or by e-mailing membership@jlsps.org.
- 2) A New Member Transfer joining the JLSP after February 1 of any year must consult with the New Member Committee Co-Chairs to determine whether she should complete the New Member Course of the current or following year. The date of transfer of a New Member Transfer is the date that information of the transfer is sent to AJLI; it is assumed with the intent of action of the New Member Transfer that she met her financial requirements with the sending Junior League and the JLSP.
- 3) A New Member Transfer must complete the transfer requirements within one year of the date of her affiliation with the JLSP. A New Member Transfer member must fulfill the New Member membership requirements.

b) Active Member Transfers

- 1) Active Members of another Junior League may transfer to the JLSP by submitting a written request for transfer to the Director of Membership by mail to JLSP Headquarters or by e-mailing membership@jlsps.org.
- 2) The Active Member Transfer will be contacted by a Placement Advisor and she will be invited to participate, if she wishes, in the New Member Course. The Active Member Transfer's Placement Advisor must notify her and review Active Member responsibilities with her. Upon consultation with her placement advisor, an Active Member Transfer may participate in the New Member Course or request a placement in the JLSP.
- 3) The date of transfer of an Active Member Transfer is the date that information of the transfer is sent to AJLI; it is assumed with the intent or action of the Active Member Transfer that she met her financial requirements with the sending Junior League and the JLSP. An Active Member Transfer must complete the transfer requirements within one year of the date of her affiliation with JLSP.
- 4) An Active Member Transfer must fulfill the Active Member requirements, except as specifically provided below.

- 5) An Active Member Transfer will not be responsible for quota contribution for the Next to New Fall Sale if her transfer date is less than six months prior to the event. An Active Member Transfer is not responsible for shift work at the Next to New Fall Sale if her transfer date is less than two months prior or the event.

c) **Sustaining Member Transfers**

- 1) Sustaining Members of another Junior League may transfer to the JLSP by submitting a written request for transfer to the Director of Membership by mail to JLSP Headquarters or by e-mailing membership@jisp.org.
- 2) The Sustaining Member Transfer will be contacted and pertinent information sent or delivered to her. The date of transfer of the Sustaining Member Transfer is the date that information of the transfer is sent to AJLI; it is assumed with the intent or action of the Sustaining Member Transfer that she met her financial requirements with the sending Junior League and the JLSP.
